



2019 Adopt-a-Plot Agreement

Terms of Agreement for Adopt-a-Plot for Harvest Community Garden of Carrollton

Harvest Community Garden (HCG) will:

Provide the garden plot, water, access to some tools, compost, and gardening information. A selection of seeds and some transplants may be available at nominal cost, when donated to the garden.

Community Gardeners agree to the following:

1. **Meetings:** All gardeners must attend a spring orientation meeting at the garden.
2. **Harvest duties:** Each gardener is responsible to work at least **10 harvest duty assignments** (5 for half plot) which will be assigned on the Duty Roster. Harvests take place on Saturday mornings. Failure to fulfill your Duty Roster responsibilities may result in revocation of your plot agreement.
3. To encourage more production and reduce wasted produce, gardeners will harvest ripe produce as needed – at least weekly.
4. Gardeners will **donate 50%** (half) by count or weight to the food pantry pick up on Saturday mornings.
5. If you are not available to do your own harvesting, arrange for another gardener to do it or inform a garden leader. Your 50% should be harvested by Friday night.
6. **Common work:** Each gardener will support HCG by doing their fair share of common work to help make this community garden successful. Gardeners will volunteer at least two (2) hours per month, in a contract period. Examples of volunteer activities: Weed common areas, turn the compost pile, seasonal garden cleanup, apply mulch in common areas, clean the shed, obtain donations, maintain hoses, fence, etc. Considerations will be given for special skills, physical and mental capabilities, and age. Youth participation is encouraged with adult guidance.
7. **Plot maintenance:** **It is the gardener's responsibility to maintain a healthy and productive plot.** If, for any reason (health, issues, work), you cannot maintain your plot, inform a garden board member. If you have a grievance with others, inform your garden board member after taking steps to resolve it yourself.
8. Gardeners will learn and use **only organic gardening** methods.
9. Gardeners will plant their plot with vegetables throughout the growing season. Year-round gardening is encouraged. Since a main goal of HCG is to provide nutritious organic *food*, less than 25% of the plot may be devoted to herbs and/or flowers. (Due to an infestation, there will be no squash planted.)
10. **Gardeners will water as necessary, weed their plot and the walkway around their plot.** Gardeners will remove diseased plants and pests from the garden and place in the dumpster (NOT the compost bins).
11. Gardeners will keep their pets out of the garden. *Never compost dog or cat feces.*
12. **Yearly fee:** Each gardener will pay a \$40 per year per assigned plot (\$20 for half a plot). Agreements expire January 1 of each year.
13. Gardeners will read and follow all guidelines and fill out and sign page 2 of this agreement.
14. Available plots shall be given to new gardeners before being given to an existing gardener. New gardeners will start with one plot their first year. The maximum allowance of the garden plots by one family or group is two plots or the number plots of you ended with the prior year.
15. The Harvest Community Garden Board and board designated garden leaders oversee the garden. These garden leaders will assign plots, assist new gardeners, report maintenance issues, check supplies, ensure that community chores are being done, check garden plots for compliance with agreement terms, and be available to resolve problems. The Garden leader meetings are open to all gardeners.
16. Gardeners must adhere to the terms stated above to continue to garden their adopted plot(s). A Board member or a board designated garden leader will contact the gardener of a grievance and work to resolve it within a specified time. If the grievance remains, then the Garden Board may revoke the plot assignment.
